Organization/Standing Committees/Youth Ministry Committee

I. Mission Statement

The mission of the Youth Ministry Committee is to provide extensive ministry opportunities for the youth of St. James Lutheran Church.

II. Committee Composition

- A. The committee shall be composed of the following members:
 - 1. Youth Minister (primary advisor)
 - 2. Church Council Liaison
 - 3. Youth Representative to Church Council
 - 4. A Pastor of the Church Staff (ex-officio member)
 - 5. Any other interested members of St. James Lutheran Church. All youth and parents are encouraged to participate with this committee.
- B. A chairperson or co-chairpersons will lead the committee.

III. Committee Responsibilities

- A. The committee shall have the following responsibilities:
 - 1. To assist the Youth Minister with planning and implementing weekly Youth Groups and special activities including, but not limited to:
 - i. Sunday Night Middle and High School Youth Group
 - ii. Wednesday Afternoon 4th and 5th Grade Youth Group
 - iii. Wednesday Morning Breakfast for Middle and High School Youth
 - iv. Summer Workcamp and/or National Youth Gathering
 - v. Alive, Alive! Middle School Synod Event
 - vi. Winterfest High School Youth Event
 - vii. Service projects to the congregation and the greater community
 - viii. Participation in the worship life of the congregation and offer leadership when able
 - 2. To oversee the Youth Ministry budget
 - 3. To determine operating policies for youth groups
 - 4. To ensure adequate resources for youth ministry in the congregation
 - 5. To develop general planning ideas and assist the Youth Minister in full program planning and implementation
 - 6. To provide opportunities for youth worker training (Gathering in the East, Youth Ministry Certification School, etc.)
 - 7. To communicate with the Property Committee regarding upkeep and maintenance of the Keyser-Foltz Youth House
- B. The committee is accountable to the church council for the oversight of these responsibilities
